The Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) curriculum is vital for young children as it lays the foundation for future learning and development. At BWI, we embrace the EYFS curriculum to ensure that every child receives a well-rounded start to their educational journey.

The Prime Areas of Learning



Communication and Language

- Importance: Developing speaking, listening, and understanding skills.
- Activities: Storytelling, singing, and interactive discussions.



Physical Development

- Importance: Enhancing fine and gross motor skills and promoting healthy lifestyles.
- Activities: Outdoor play, dance, and fine motor skill exercises like threading and cutting.



Personal, Social, and Emotional Development

- Importance: Building self-confidence, managing feelings, and forming positive relationships.
- Activities: Role-play, group activities, and mindfulness exercises.



The Specific Areas of Learning



Literacy

- Importance: Fostering a love for reading and writing.
- Activities: Reading sessions, phonics games, and writing practice



Mathematics

- Importance: Developing number sense, spatial awareness, and problem-solving skills.
- Activities: Counting games, puzzles, and shape exploration.



Understanding the World

- Importance: Encouraging curiosity about the environment, people, and cultures.
- Activities: Nature walks, cultural celebrations, and science experiments



Expressive Arts and Design

- Importance: Stimulating creativity and imagination.
- Activities: Art projects, music sessions, and imaginative play.

A - Awesome Arrival

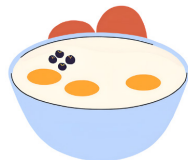
Starting the day with a warm welcome helps children transition smoothly from home to school, fostering a sense of security and readiness for learning.

Encouraging empathy, respect and problem-solving through exploration and hands-on activities that promote sharing, taking turns, and a love for learning through play.



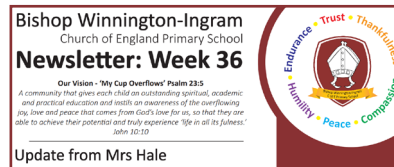


Working Together In partnership

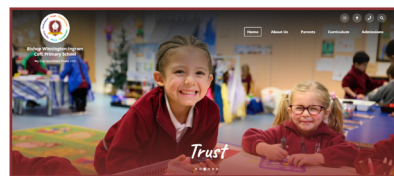
