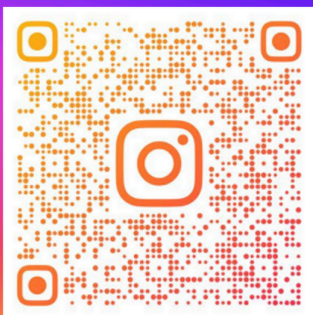

## Nursery



In Nursery this week we've been reading 'Rosie's Walk'. We've been using lots of positional language and mark making in flour. We visited the School Library for the first time to choose a book to take home to share.

## Adventurers



This week we have been exploring our story Ruby's Worry. Within this we have been exploring fantastic vocabulary relating to our emotions. This week we have started learning the phonics sounds s, a, t and p.

## Discoverers



This week in Phonics we have been learning 'oy' saying oi. In English we have been writing our own version of 'The Bear and the Piano.' In Maths we have been learning 1 more and 1 less using numbers to 10.

## Explorers



This week in math's we have been learning to partition numbers to 100. We had fun in Geography learning about the coldest places on Earth and in PE we practiced our underarm throwing skills.

## Investigators



This week in math's we have been learning to estimate where numbers are on the number line. In RE we are continuing our learning on The Lord's Prayer and in Science we learnt about different habitats.

The children have been looking at teeth, how to look after them and what the different teeth are for. We have started an experiment this week to see the affects of different substances on our teeth. We are all keen to look at the results next week.
