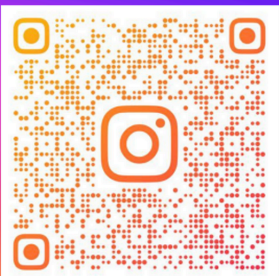

Nursery



This week in Nursery we have continued our 'People who help us' topic and have been learning about the Police. We made police cars and enjoyed dressing up in our police station. In maths we have been matching numerals to quantities.

Adventurers



This week in Reception, we had a great time taking part in our pedestrian training, where we learned how to cross the road safely. We also enjoyed getting creative by making polar bears using our hands and paint!

Discoverers



This week, we have been writing sentences describing Pinocchio's adventures. In Phonics we have been learning y saying 'ee.' During our Maths lesson we have been learning about the value of numbers 11 to 20. In History we have been looking at the toys our parents and grandparents played with.

Explorers



This week in D&T we designed a pattern for our moving monsters. In math's we are learning to share equally and to divide equal numbers. In Geography we discussed and located some of the worlds most amazing human and physical features and in RE we continued learning about the Jewish faith by tasting apples and honey for Rosh Hashanah.

Investigators



Investigators have finished off their work on 3s, 5s/10s, and 2s/4s/8s in Maths and will be moving onto using these in multiplication and division reasoning problems. They have enjoyed showing rather than telling how their characters feel in their traditional story based on The Magic Paintbrush and had fun playing pentatonic Chinese melodies on glockenspiels in Music.

Pathfinders



In RE we have been studying how Hindus worship and how they believe in one supreme being - Brahman. In history we have been studying the Indus Valley civilisation and key figures in that time.

Groundbreakers



The children have been working really hard this week in Maths. We have been learning how to add and subtract fractions with different denominators, including when we have to break the whole. We have begun to read Treason to find out about the life and behaviours of King Henry VIII and the Tudors. We are looking forward to going to the Science Museum next week on Wednesday to discover more about Space.

Trailblazers



This week, Trailblazers have demonstrated fantastic commitment in their SATs preparation, covering Reading, Maths and SPaG. In Maths, we have started our new Algebra topic, exploring 1- and 2-step function machines. We have also continued with our key text, focusing on the pros and cons of xenotransplantation and developing thoughtful discussion around this complex issue.



Thought for the week



While Jesus was praying, heaven was opened, and the Holy Spirit came down upon him ... And a voice came from heaven, "You are my own dear Son. I am pleased with you." - Luke 3:21-22

This moment in Jesus' life is often called his baptism, and it tells us something really special: before Jesus began his teaching, before the miracles, before the crowds, God reminded him that he was loved and valued. God didn't say, "I am pleased with you because of what you have done," but simply, "I am pleased with you."

In school, it can be easy for us to think our worth comes from achievements—our test scores, how fast we run, how well we read, or how neat our work looks. But this passage reminds us that God loves us for who we are, not just for what we do. When we make time to pause and pray—like Jesus did—we can be reminded of that same truth: we are deeply loved, known and valued.

Something to pray

Dear God,

Thank you that before anything else, you love us for who we are.

Help us to remember that our value does not come from achievements, but from being your children.

As we work, play and learn this week, may we encourage others and help them to feel known and valued too.

Either log in to your account if you have booked with us before, or register for a new account if this is your first time.
2. If you need to add a second child to your booking please contact directly
3. Add chosen class to basket and check out
4. Once the payment has been made you will receive a confirmation email and shortly after you will be contacted to sign up to the portal where you will be able to view term dates and skill sets. Once done, you will be able to access the portal both on computer and via app to view class dates, weekly assessment results and invoices.
