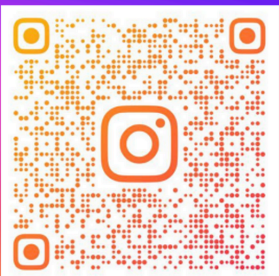

Nursery



This week in Nursery we have been learning about the role of a teacher and the children have enjoyed creating portraits of the Nursery staff. In maths, we have been exploring a range of different patterns.

Adventurers



This week in Reception, we've been learning all about the numbers six, seven and eight. We also had lots of fun at our disco on Thursday and loved dancing to all of our favourite songs!

Discoverers



We have been writing the story of Pinocchio in our 'First of the Month' books. Our phonics sound this week is ow and oe saying 'oa.' In Maths we have started adding and subtracting using numbers to 20. In History we have been looking at similarities and differences of toys from the past and present.

Explorers



In English we have begun our new topic on 'The Great Fire of London' and we have been learning facts and describing the scenes. In music we have been learning to sing 'London Bridge is Falling Down'. In Maths we have begun our new unit of learning on money.

Investigators



Year 3 have been improving their retellings of The Magic Paintbrush ready for their First of the Month books. In Maths they have been applying their times tables knowledge to reasoning problems - regular practise at home on TTR really helps make this easier for them!

Pathfinders



The children really enjoyed their trip to the Hindu temple on Monday and were really well behaved, the temple emailed to say how impressed they were and how thoughtful their questions were. In English, we have started a new unit and will be writing a factual tour of a raindrop.

Groundbreakers



We have also been developing our resilience when learning how to multiply 3 digit by 2 digit numbers. We have focused on steps to success and fluency to build our confidence. Our trip to the Science Museum and our Computing lessons have both helped us so much with our Mars Rover writing topic.

Trailblazers



In English, the children have begun a new text that links closely with our science learning on adaptation and evolution with thoughtful cross-curricular connections. In Maths, we have reached the end of our Algebra unit. Pupils demonstrate a strong understanding of how to solve algebraic problems!
