UPDATE FROM MRS RODENAS

Recent weeks have brought plenty of wet and gloomy weather, but this has not taken away from the energy and positivity seen throughout the school. Even on the rainiest days, classrooms have remained busy and full of life, with children continuing to learn, play and enjoy their time in school. Their resilience, enthusiasm and good spirits have been a real pleasure to see.

It has also been a highlight to spend time looking through the children's First of the Month books. The progress evident over time is impressive, whether in the care taken with presentation, growing confidence, increased stamina or the depth and quality of learning shown in their work. These books reflect not only the children's efforts, but also the thoughtful support and high expectations provided by staff as each child is encouraged to develop and flourish.

Next week we will be marking Children's Mental Health Week, with this year's theme This is My Place. The focus is on helping children feel secure and confident in who they are, with a strong sense of belonging within their families, friendships and school community. As a Christian school, this also includes helping children understand their place as part of God's family, where they are valued, accepted and supported.

A range of activities will take place across the week to explore this theme, including assemblies, PSHE and art lessons that focus on identity and belonging, as well as a live Picture News assembly. The week will end with a non uniform day on Friday 13 February, when children are invited to wear bright or colourful clothing or accessories to celebrate community and togetherness. A suggested donation of £1 will be collected.

Children's Mental Health Week gives us an important opportunity to pause and remind our pupils that they are seen, they are valued and they play an important role in the life of our school.

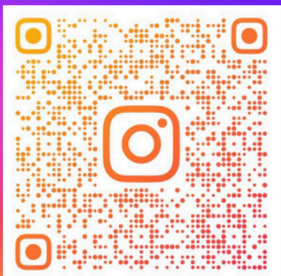

Nursery



This week we have enjoyed learning about vets and the animals they look after. We had a visit from a veterinary nurse and had fun dressing Mrs Cowling up as a vet! In maths, we have been taking and giving 1, 2 and 3 and working on recognising numbers.

Adventurers



This week in Reception, we have been exploring snow and winter. The children used their fingers to paint snow onto trees, developing their creativity and fine motor skills. We have also been creating structures outdoors to see if we could make them waterproof from the rain or snow.

Discoverers



We have been writing information about toys from the past as part of our non-fiction unit. In Phonics we have been learning wh saying 'w.' In RE we have been learning about the different areas of a Synagogue and in History we have been looking at how teddy bears have changed over time.

Explorers



This week in Science we tested the stretchiness of different materials. In Geography we completed fieldwork on finding habitats in the local area and creating tally and bar charts of our findings. In English we are continuing to describe The Great Fire of London.

Investigators



Investigators have been using multiplication and division in scaling and correspondence problems this week, while in English they have been using labels and puns in their explanation text about things underground. In Science they learned about what soil is made from and the different types.

Pathfinders



In maths, Pathfinders have been finding the perimeter of different shapes and calculating missing lengths. In PSHE, the children have been learning about mistakes and how we can learn from those mistakes. In computing, they have been creating their own websites.

Groundbreakers



Year 5 have been thoroughly enjoying learning about the life of Henry VIII and his 6 wives, why he came to the decision to divorce or behead 5 of them and the impact of his many decisions on Britain. We have also continued challenging ourselves in Maths with 3 by 2 and 4 by 2 digit multiplication

Trailblazers



We are reaching the end of our Decimals unit, with pupils confidently applying their skills in a range of problems. In English, the children are producing engaging non-chronological reports based on their chosen animals. Art lessons have focused on how artists use mixed media to convey powerful messages, encouraging creativity and self-expression.
