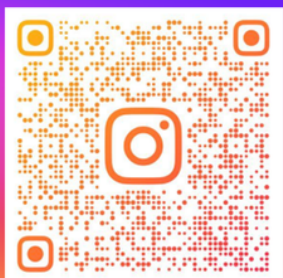

Nursery



This week in Nursery we have 'dived down' under the sea to explore. The children have enjoyed learning about sea creatures, making jelly fish and have been moving like crabs whilst using musical instruments. To celebrate Science week we have made a rainbow with skittles.

Adventurers



In Adventurers this week we have been talking about sharing in PSHE. We looked at why sharing is important and how it makes us feel to share and have someone share with us. In Maths we began exploring length and height.

Discoverers



We have been planning for our retell of the story of 'The Storm Whale.' In Phonics we have been learning ea saying 'e' like in the word bread. In Maths we have started place value to 50 and counting in 10s. In Geography we have been learning compass directions and in Science we have been finding out about birds.

Explorers



This week in science we investigated growth and had fun measuring each other and finding out how tall we all are. In RE we learnt about the last supper in more detail and in maths we are learning fractions, finding a half, quarter and thirds.

Investigators



Investigators have been enjoying British Science Week in school! We loved our assemblies with the Bishop Ramsey Science department demonstrating lots of amazing experiments and Ruislip Baptist Church sharing about faith and Science designed by our creator God.

Pathfinders



This week in Year 4 we have been converting improper fractions to mixed numbers and looking at equivalent fractions on a number line. In Geography we have been study the Rainforest, looking specifically at the indigenous people that live there.

Groundbreakers



Year 5 have been writing about an exciting day out to the zoo, we have been practicing comprehension from short extracts of popular books and learning how to calculate fractions of amounts. We learnt how to use MakeCodeArcade and MicroBits to program our own pedometers.

Trailblazers



Trailblazers have approached their SATs this week with fantastic determination and focus—well done to them all! In Science, they have been learning about the components of electrical circuits and practising how to draw circuit diagrams using standardised symbols. Meanwhile, in History, pupils have been writing diary entries to imagine what life was like for children living through the The Blitz.

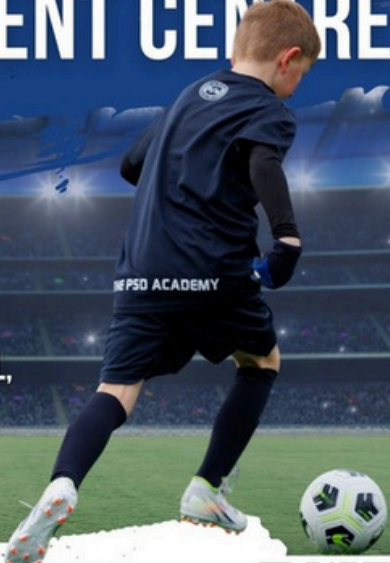
