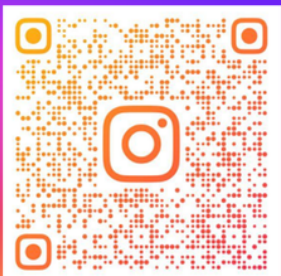

# How our cup has overflowed this week!

## Nursery



This week in Nursery we have been to 'The Cafe!' The children have enjoyed decorating cup cakes and making pizzas. Outside, they loved making hot chocolate with marshmallows. In phonics they continued looking at the initial sounds of items found in a cafe.

## Adventurers



This week in Reception, we have been retelling the story of Handa's Surprise. We used animal masks and different fruits to help bring the story to life. Afterwards, we practiced our cutting skills by cutting out pictures from the story and sequencing them in the correct order.

## Discoverers



This week, Discoverers learned about how Muslims practice Wudu before prayer and impressed with their knowledge of Islam. They also had a great time identifying different animal groups at London Zoo.

## Explorers



This week we have been learning to tell the time to a quarter past/to and past the hour. In science we drew and labelled the life cycle of a plant. In RE we had a visitor in to teach us all about the Muslim faith and in geography we learnt about the coast and its physical features.

## Investigators



Investigators have been finalising their own poems and learning to recite poetry. They have also finished their unit on fractions and enjoyed seeing the results of their observational enquiry which proved that water is transported through plants through tubes in the stem. Their geography about Shackleton and Antarctica was fascinating!

## Pathfinders



This week in Maths, we have been working on money and solving a range of money problems. During English lessons, the children explored the River Poem by Valerie Bloom and created their own poems in a similar style. In Science, we learned about how climate change, deforestation and plastic pollution can harm environments and animals.

## Groundbreakers



Year 5 have been exploring the question 'Does the material a parachute is made of (fabric or plastic) affect the time it takes for it to fall to the ground?'. We have used a lot of resilience and problem solving to work out how to make the parachutes so they don't rip and so that the string stays firmly attached.

Congratulations to our Year 6 children, who have shown tremendous perseverance and resilience throughout their SATs — we are incredibly proud of you all. We were also delighted to welcome Holy Trinity to BWI for an afternoon of exciting sports activities to celebrate the end of the week.



## Thought for the week



While Paul was waiting for them in Athens, he was greatly distressed to see that the city was full of idols. Acts 17:16

This week's Bible verse reminds us that when Paul visited Athens, he noticed that many people were focusing their attention on idols instead of on God. 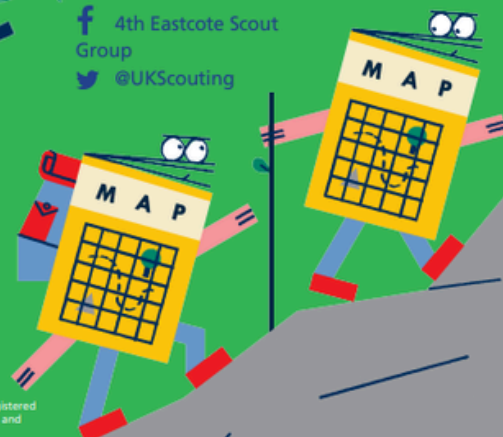
