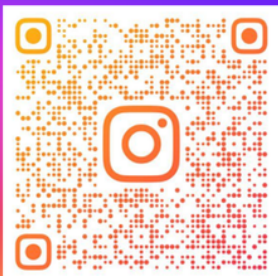

Nursery



This week in Nursery the children have been learning about 'The Garden Centre'. They have enjoyed planting beans, sunflowers and learning all about the things flowers need to grow. In phonics the children have been blending and listening to the initial sounds of things we find in a garden centre.

Adventurers



This week in Reception, we have enjoyed having lots of fun taking part in different activities related to The Proudest Blue. We even spent one afternoon on the field enjoying football, fruit and ice pops in the sunshine!

Discoverers



We have been writing a recount of our trip to London Zoo. In Phonics we have continued to revisit previously taught sounds. In Maths we have been finding half and a quarter of a shape. In Geography we have been making comparisons between where we live, and Shanghai, China. In Design and Technology this week we made delicious smoothies!

Explorers



In PE we have been practising the hurdles and egg and spoon race in preparation for sports day. In maths we completed our unit on time. In Geography we wrote a radio advert for Weymouth to entice people to visit the coastal town. We also had fun learning all about road safety in our pedestrian training session where we went out onto the roads to practise our skills.

Investigators



Investigators have been learning about adding and subtracting money this week and have reinforced where and when to use capital letters and full stops consistently. In Science they identified the reproductive parts of flowering plants and in computing have discussed how content online can negatively impact our feelings.

Pathfinders



In Maths this week, we have been converting analogue and digital time. We then used these skills to solve two-step word problems. In RE, we continued to study Buddhism and considered the ideas of samsara and nirvana. Samsara is the endless cycle of birth, death, and rebirth, driven by karma, ignorance, and attachment.

Year 5 have had another busy week, we have finished our First of the Month writing about Plastic Pollution. We are continuing to read Tom's Midnight Garden and are enjoying discussing the interactions between Tom, Hatty and the other characters.

Trailblazers



Trailblazers have enjoyed a variety of fun activities while the others have been away on PGL. The children had fun decorating biscuits and making colourful fruit kebabs, as well as becoming fashion designers by creating their own unique outfits from newspaper. They also enjoyed trips around the local area and finished the week with a film afternoon.
