How our cup has overflowed this week!

Nursery

This week, we have been learning about castles. The children enjoyed building castles with both large and small construction bricks and exploring the different features of a castle. In phonics, we practised identifying initial sounds in castle-themed words.

Adventurers

We have been exploring positional language through our small world play activities. The children have been using words such as on, under, behind, next to, in front of, and between to describe the positions of objects and characters.

Discoverers

In English this week, we have been writing sentences including adjectives to describe the moon. In Phonics we have been reading and writing words adding 'ed.' In Maths we have been comparing numbers to 100 that have the same number of tens.

Explorers

This week in art we used clay to create tiles. We have also used paint to create a place mat with a garden theme. In math's we worked on drawing and interpreting pictograms. In RE we began our new topic and thought about the question 'Why do people belong to a Christian community?'

Investigators

Investigators have been finishing their letter based on 'The Gardener' in English and have been considering time in terms of am and pm, days, weeks, months and years, as well as reading time on digital clocks in Maths. In RE we continued our 'I am' statements Jesus made in our 'Who is Jesus?' unit

Pathfinders

In RE, we began our new Christianity unit, 'Why is the liturgy important to many Christians?' The children explored the key elements of Christian public worship and discussed why these are important to believers. In Maths, we have been identifying and comparing angles, as well as recognising and classifying different types of triangles.

Groundbreakers

We have had a fantastic week consolidating our arithmetic skills and have thoroughly enjoyed letting our imaginations run wild through our writing inspired by The Nowhere Emporium. We have also loved beginning our new Geography topic on deserts.

Trailblazers

This week, we have been including dialogue to advance the action in a narrative. This has been in addition to weaving in literary devices such as personification, adverbials of time and place, along with pathetic fallacy to enhance the description and emphasise the eerie atmosphere that surrounded the events that unfolded at Quetico Provincial Park.
