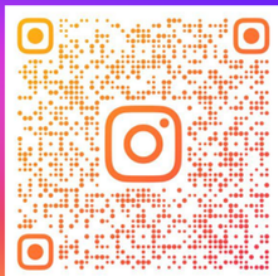

Our uniform expectations

There is an expectation for parents/carers to work in partnership to ensure pupils are correctly dressed in school uniform, in keeping with our high standards.

Pupils in Reception - Year 6

- A V-necked grey jumper or cardigan with the school logo as supplied;
- a white shirt;
- burgundy pinafore or knee length, pleated or 'A'-line skirt; mid grey plain, straight trousers or shorts; school tie (not elasticated).
- Plain burgundy or black tights; white / grey socks (no trainer socks)
- Black, flat shoes (no open toe / back) to be worn, no boots
- Pink checked summer dresses / culottes style dresses can be worn from the beginning of the Summer Term through to 1st October.

Reception children only: Wellington boots (any colour) also required - to be kept in school.

PE Kit

- White round neck tee-shirt - with logo; black shorts
- Plain burgundy sweatshirt (can be zip-through hoodie style without neck drawstrings) (no sports brands/logos)
- Plain black jogging trousers (no sports brands/logos)
- Trainers suitable for PE (no astro trainers/boots)

Please note: From September, children will need to use the BWI school bag or book bag. This helps to ensure that all children have a practical, appropriately sized bag for school while also removing the expectation or pressure to purchase large or expensive bags from other retailers. How our cup has overflowed this week!

Nursery



This week in Nursery, we had a wonderful visit from Wild Fangs, where the children enjoyed meeting a range of exotic animals. We also kept cool with water play and ice pops in the warm weather. In phonics, the children continued to practise blending CVC words using their robot arms.

Adventurers



We have had a great time exploring and revisiting our number bonds to 10. We used beanbags outside to play fun games and activities to help us practice and strengthen our understanding of these important number facts.

Discoverers



This week we have been recapping previously learnt sounds in Phonics and in English we have been looking at poetry and rhyming patterns. In Maths we have been learning 'o'clock' and 'half past' times. In RE we have been learning about the parable of 'The Good Samaritan.' In History we have been looking at how exploration has changed over time.

Explorers



This week we have continued learning about Grace Darling in English, focussing on her early life and how she felt when she saw the storm and wrecked ship. In maths we have been revising 2D and 3D shapes. In Science we are learning about 'our bodies' and focussed this week on healthy eating.

Investigators



Investigators have completed their Shape topic in maths and have begun their final unit on Statistics. They have been working on more of their alternative fairy tale based on 'The Real Story of the Three Little Pigs', and enjoyed a visit from a hive of honeybees which furthered our recent learning on pollination in Science.

Pathfinders



This week in Maths, we have been learning about Position and Direction, with the children practising reading and plotting coordinates, describing movement and turns, and using mathematical language such as clockwise, anticlockwise, and translation.

Groundbreakers



We have revised decimals, we have taken part in a Taskmaster challenge to collect the most unusual and innovative data in Maths as part of our statistics topics, we have read some fascinating comprehension texts, we have continued writing our own versions of The Nowhere Emporium and taken part in a brilliant Science and PE taster day at Bishop Ramsey.

We had a wonderful time at Bishop Ramsey this week and the Battle of Britain bunker today. We are really looking forward to seeing you all next week for our performance.
