Year 4 Spring Term Overview

READING

During daily reading lessons, the children will practise a range of reading skills, including: retrieval (finding information), inference (using clues to deduce information), summary, and analysis of vocabulary. They will also make predictions, identify features of different texts and make comparisons between books.



In the Spring term, children will be reading **Special Occasion Clothes** by Jane Bingham and **The Explorer** by Katherine Rundell.

WRITING

In Spring 1, our writing is linked to our geography work on the rainforest; we look at how pollution is affecting our world and write a newspaper article about animals that suffer and die from plastic in our oceans.



In Spring 2, our writing will be linked to our reading book, **The Explorer**. We will also make connections with our unit on the **Anglo-Saxons** and why people have constantly moved around and explored our planet throughout history.
